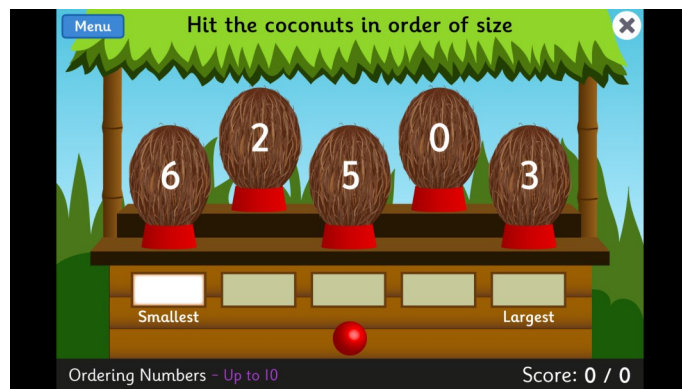
During World Book Day we learn lots about reading. But... we do not want to lose our maths skills. So today we are going to practice our maths skills through some games.

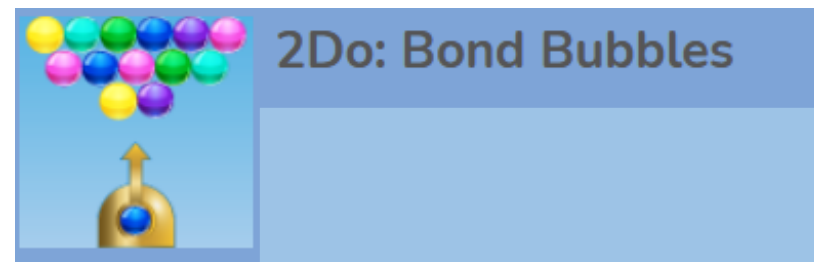

Your top trump card must include

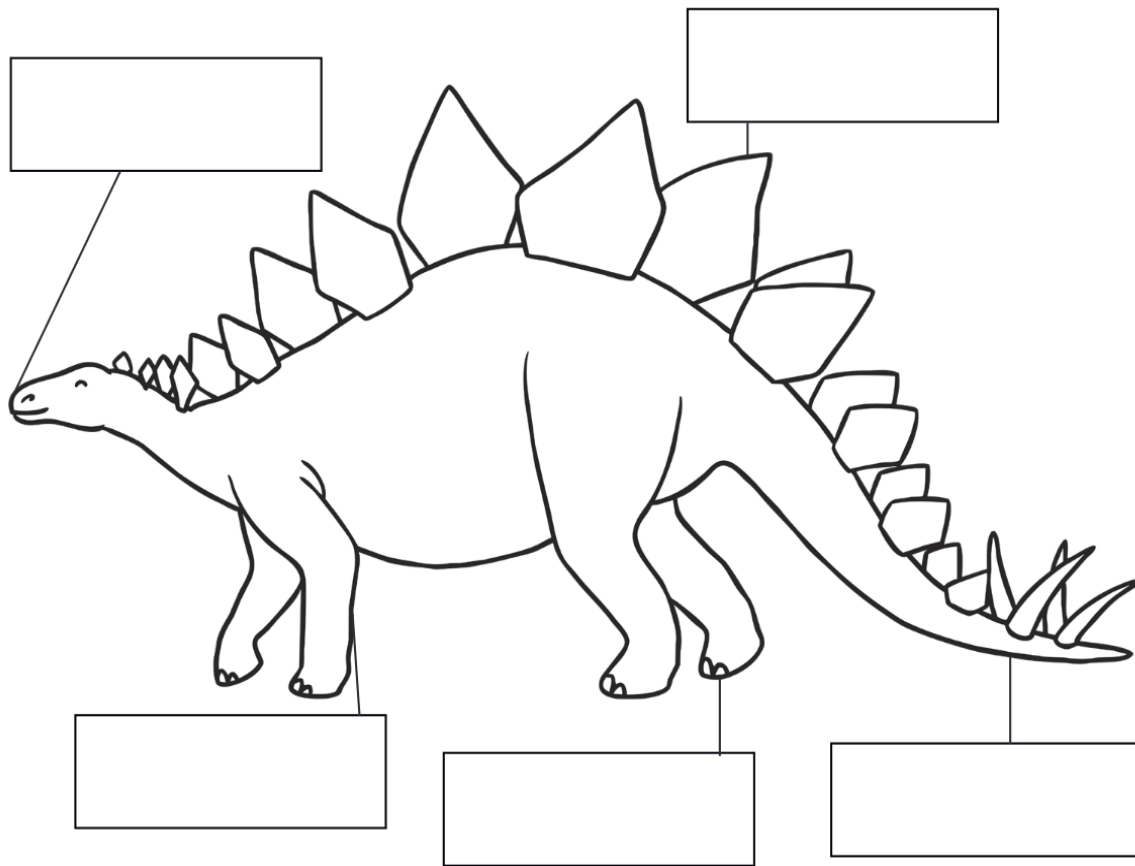
- Dinosaurs name

Mouth- They use this to eat.

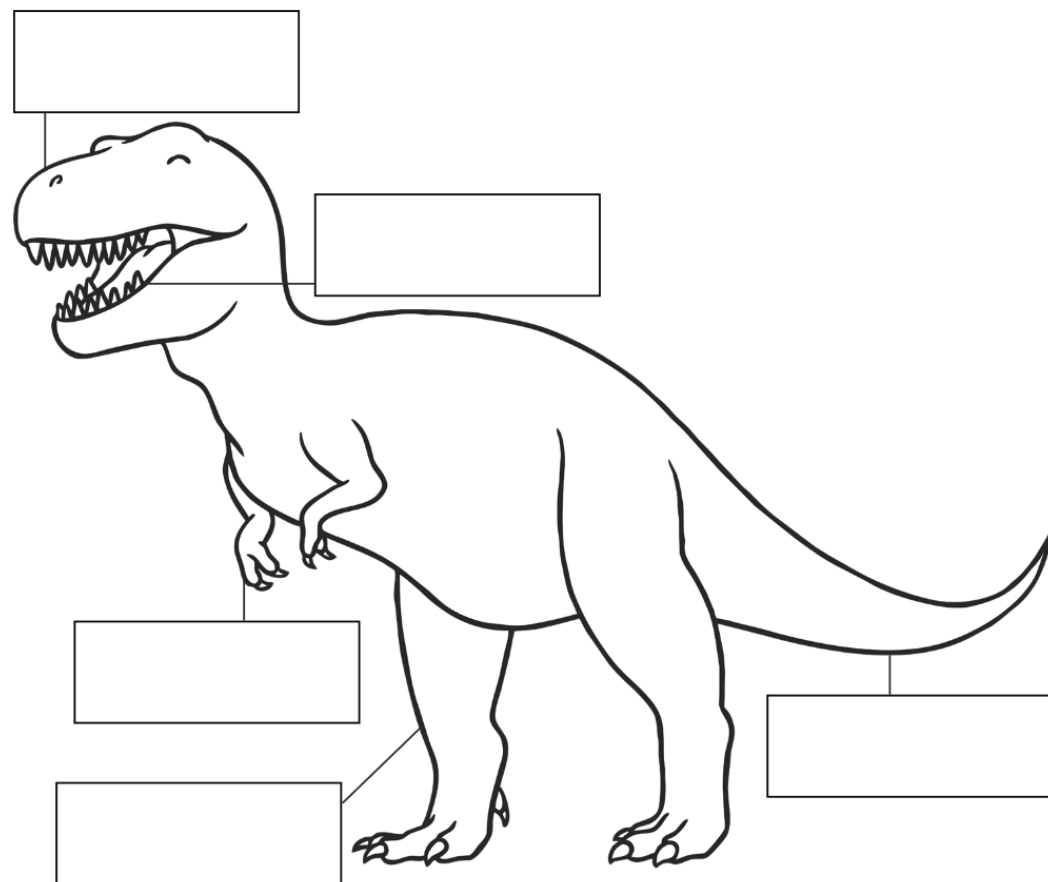
Nail- These are found on their feet.

Claws- These are sharp and are on their hands and feet.

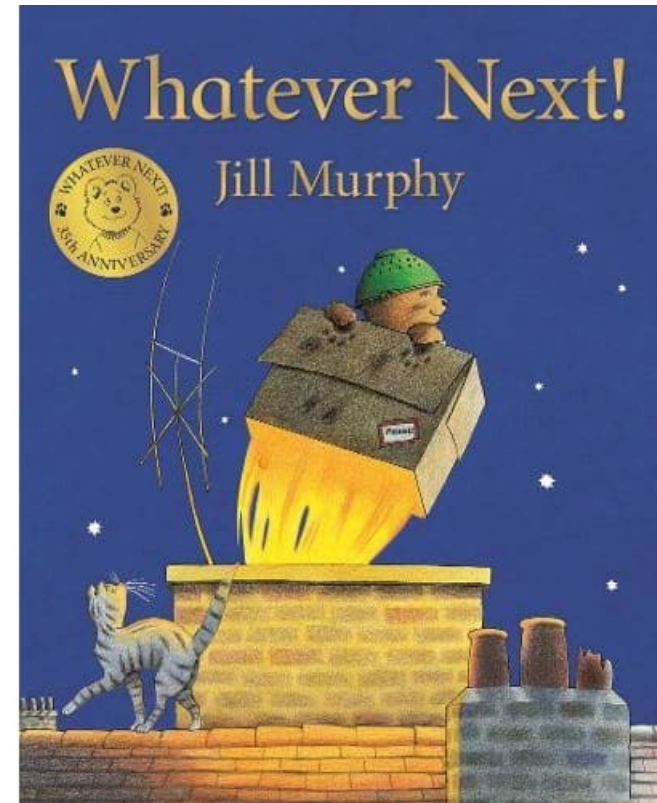
Teeth- These are sharp and help the dinosaurs eat.

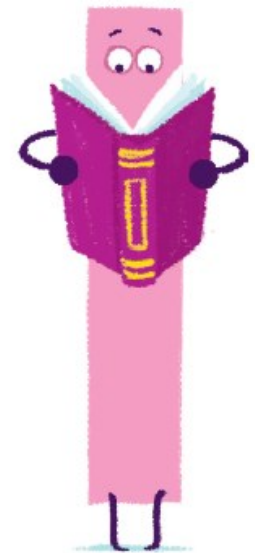
