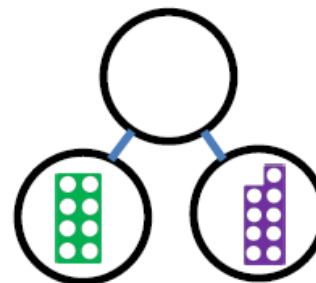

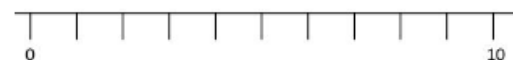

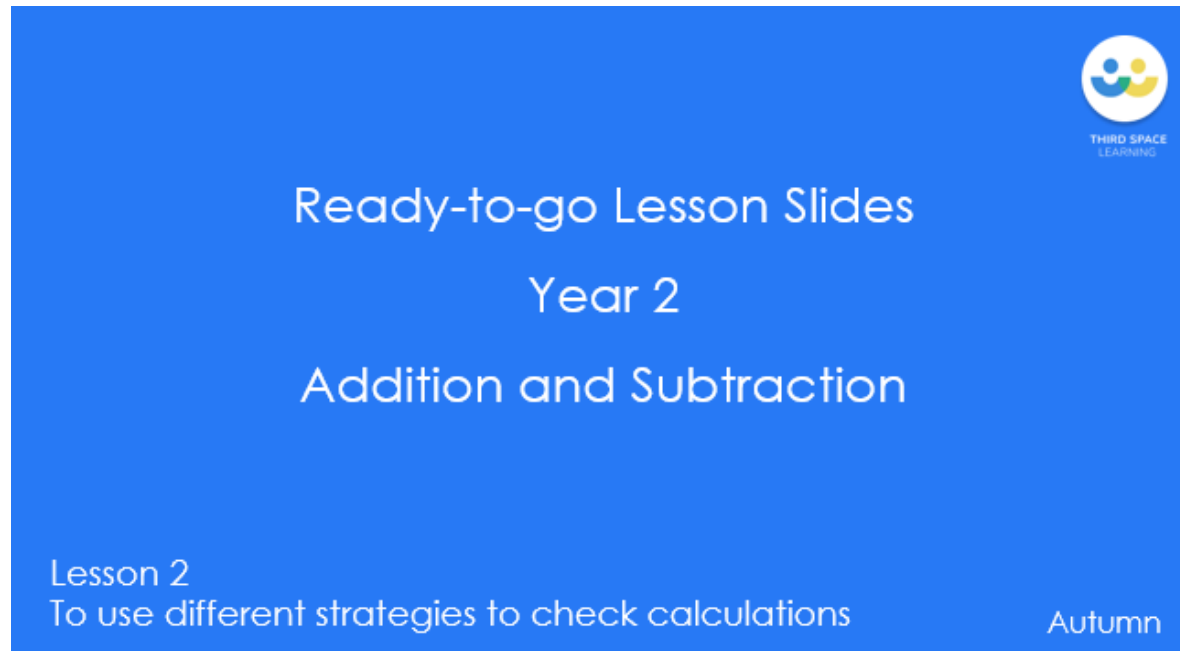

The hard c sound is made when the letter c meets a, o, or u. (cat and corn)
