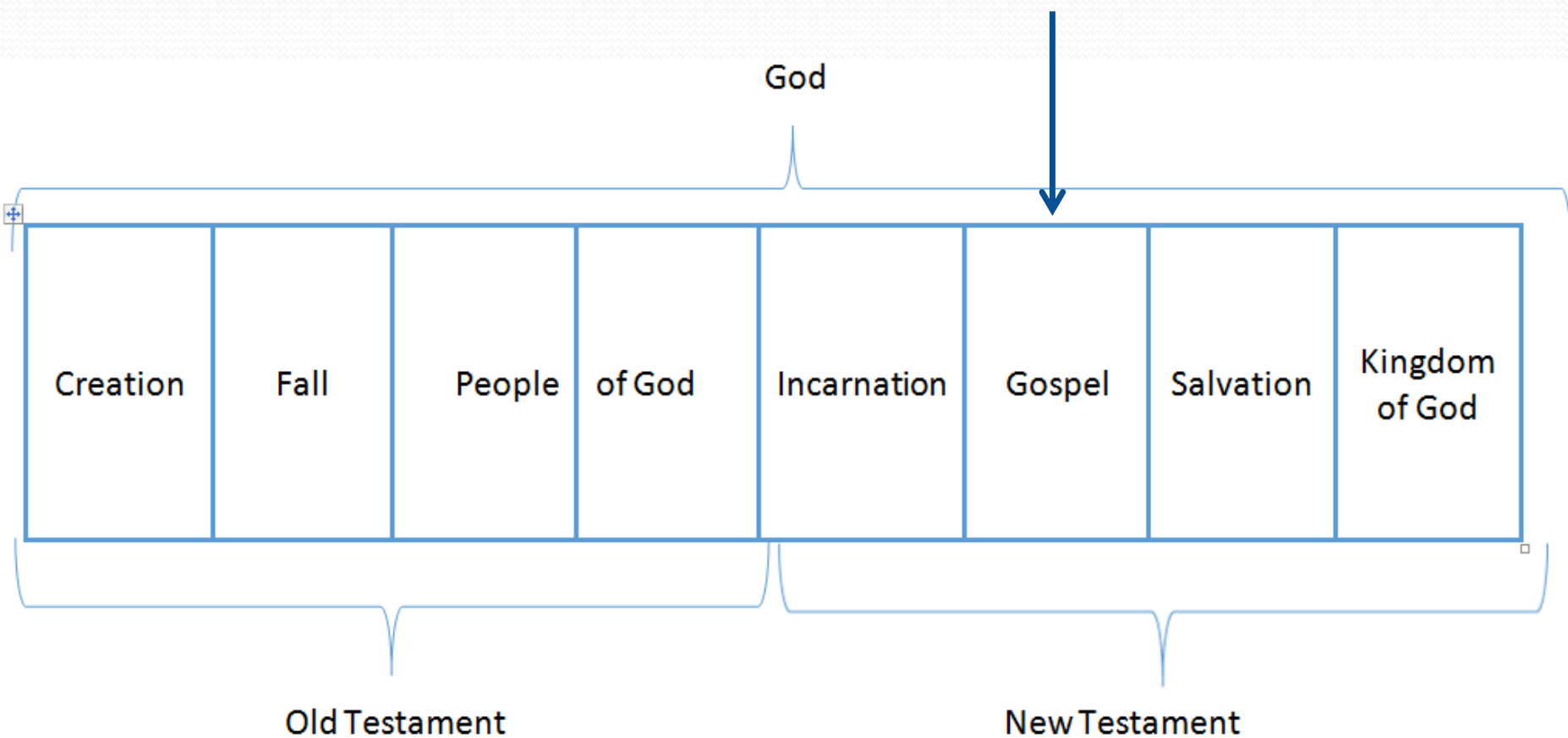

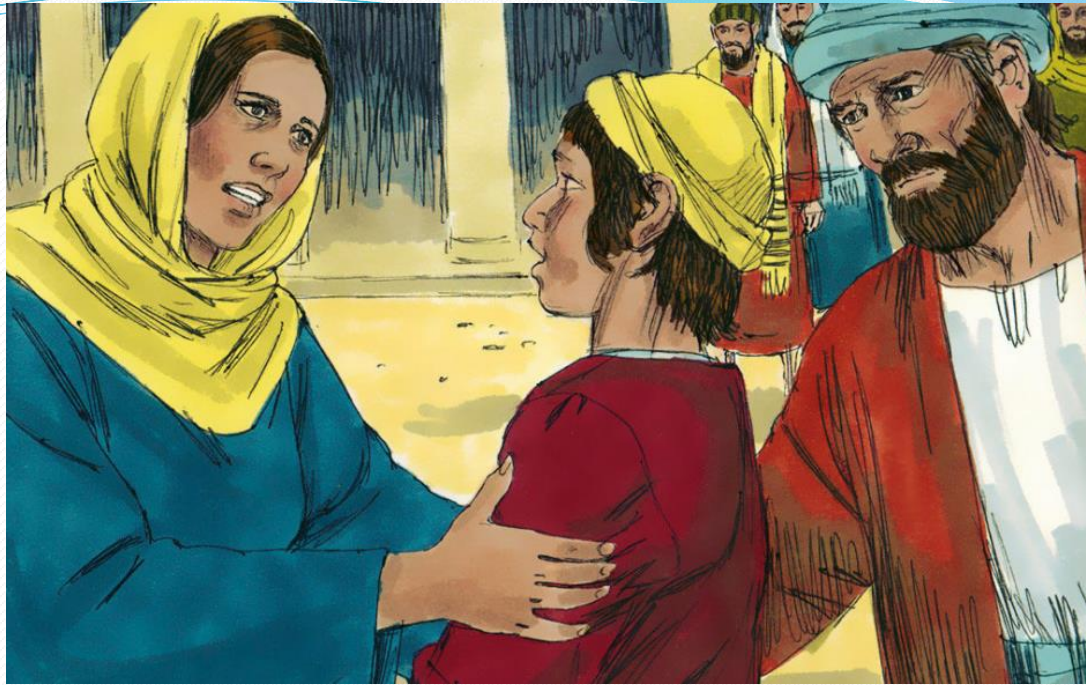

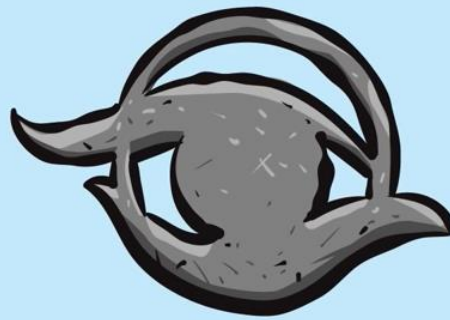




We know very little about Jesus' childhood, but in today's story, Jesus is 12 twelve years old and he gets lost in the temple.
