This week's skill is prediction. This means we will guess what happens next, using our knowledge of the world. This often means that there is more than one correct answer.

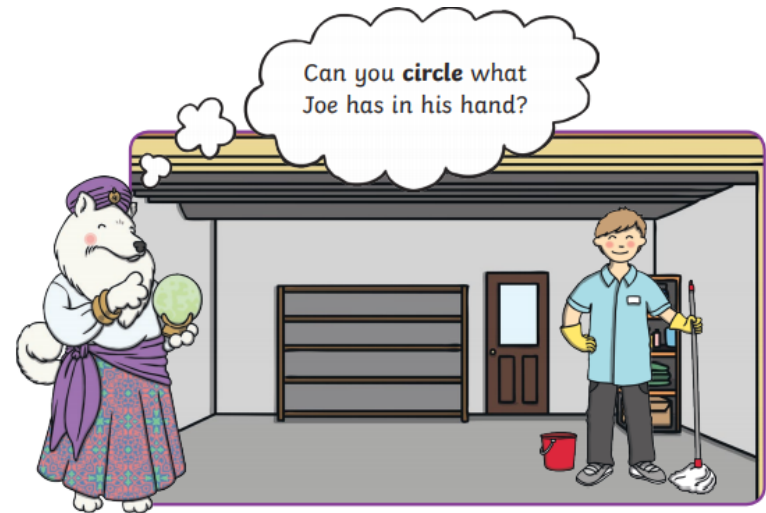
